

Appendix AI - Campus and Community Culture

Examples of campus and community initiatives and partnerships that integrate different demographic groups:

- “HSU Downtown” includes four events that are free and exclusively for Humboldt State students. Two nights of DJs and dancing are held at the Arcata Theatre Lounge, and two movie nights are scheduled at the Minor Theatre.
- [AS Presents](#) collaborates with the university to provide student-driven and student-oriented speakers, workshops, and performances.
- College socials have been held to provide off-campus socialization among faculty, staff, and administrators to foster mutual respect and collegiality.
- HSU has hosted several inclusive stakeholder dialogues and forums since 2014. Examples include the Campus Dialogue on Race, "Advancing Equity Through a Racial Lens," "What Now? A Dialogue on Oppression and Inequity on Campus and in our Community," and "Making a More Inclusive and Safer Community."
- Program changes at HSU to help with retention and success for URG students have been implemented through the Department of [Critical Race, Gender, and Sexuality Studies](#) and include:
 - creation of a new online journal titled [CouRaGeouS Cuentos](#) that publishes selected writings by students in ES 107: Chican@/Latin@ Lives,
 - creation of a new course titled ES 480: Growing up Chican@/Latin@,
 - creation of new minor in Black Studies, and
 - transformation of a one-unit Trans Lives and Theories special-topics seminar into a semester-long three-unit course (CRGS 321).
